## Study Guide November 26, 2017

**Monday November 27th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Ezekial 34:11-16** Take comfort this week that the Great Shepherd has always intended to care for us. In all of our trials, when we are lost, alone, overwhelmed, sad, or hopeless, God will provide for us.

**Question:** How could this passage become part of your prayer life? What comfort do you take from it? How can it strengthen you?

**Tuesday November 28th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Ephesians 1:15-23** Paul is writing to the believers in Ephesus to encourage and reassure them. It is a blessing to be prayed for, isn't it? Paul prays for those who read his letter and calls on them to rest in the knowledge that God has all things on earth and heaven under control.

**Question:** When someone tells you that they are praying for you what is your reaction? Do the words "I am praying for you" have an impact in your life?

**Wednesday November 29th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Psalm 65** The psalmist retells all of the goodness and blessings that God has given to his people. In this frenetic season, read this as a prayer full of praise to the one true God.

**Question:** What words will you add to this psalm? How many blessings has God rained down on you?

**Thursday November 30th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Psalm 100** This is the day to sing and dance and shout for joy for all of the blessings you appreciate in your life. This is the day to celebrate the goodness and wonders you have received. Sing today—sing every day of the goodness you have received from our Heavenly Father.

**Question:** When you worship God, do you sing with joy? Can you ever thank God enough? Have you wondered why you?

**Friday November 31st** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Matthew 25:31-46** I find this to be one of the most frightening passages of judgement in Scripture. Jesus is very clear about what happens when you do not follow his commands. We are blessed and we are called to be blessings to those who are in need.

**Question:** How do you respond to Jesus's very clear instructions? Should you serve Jesus from fear or in response to the many things you have to be thankful for?

*As you pray this week remember our church, both here in Bensalem and our world-wide church. Pray for those who will not be home for Thanksgiving, for those who have no home, for those who are sick, for those neighbors who are hungry, who have nothing.*
